
Founded in 2007 in New York

## Vector enables artists to generate their own wealth based on the efforts of their creativity

Within the art world one of the major problems that artists face is they don't have a reliable or stable income stream.

Vector is creating an ecosystem to solve this problem by providing a mechanism where artists who are curated into the system can generate an income.

The cross-chain digital platform (Metachain) uses a proprietary blockchain based tokenization method that provides authentication, valuation, and royalty tracking for works of art.

This platform is fueled by Vector Smart Contracts "Vector Shares". Each Vector is minted from the valuation of a work of art (proof of creativity) and acts as a "share" of ownership. The Artist now has an independent mechanism to convert their work directly into a liquid fractionalized tradable asset.

Artists will have the power to generate the income they need when they need it.

The mission of Vector is to create the world's first global art exchange and ledger system to expose art to the largest audience possible, to facilitate cataloging, investment, and discovery.

Our goal is to put the artist first and give them the greatest amount of support while their work reaches the widest number of possible supporters.

## **PROJECT /**

Vector is developing a proprietary, blockchain based system for authentication, valuation, and royalty tracking for works of art.

This system greatly improves the inefficiencies in the art market, while keeping global distribution and profit systems in place.

This platform allows art institutions to add works to an unbreakable ledger system, either analog or digital.

The ecosystem enables smart contracts, has an internal art market, investment platform, and provides a historical ledger.

Through leveraging our existing relationships in the art world, Vector is positioned to become an innovative platform for the global art market.

## **INEFFICIENCIES /**

Depleting public funding for the arts. No "globally" adhered to system for valuation. No liquidity in art investments.

> No method of royalty distribution. Limited ability for artists to generate income. Lack of security and trust in NFT exchanges.

> > No global standard for privately held ledgers of work. Art funds and auction systems are highly restrictive. Varying degrees of reliability in authenticating works of art.

> > > Limited opportunities for people to invest in art with small contributions. No reliable way to fractionalize ownership of a single piece of artwork. No system to speculate and invest in art without purchasing the underlying asset.

## SOLUTIONS /

Income stream for artists and institutions. Asset-backed cryptocurrency. Fractional ownership of artwork.

Royalty tracking for works of art. Artists can reach a global audience. Investors can make speculate investments.

Vector is a "NASDAQ" for the art market. Real time data transparency. A "Library of Alexandria" for the art world.

Tokenized art is a liquid asset. Multiple investors in a single work of art. Immutable ledger records chain of ownership. Facilitates cataloging, investment, and discovery.


## ART FUND /

The Vector Art Fund will be the store of value for the Vector platform.


Artwork is purchased, stored, value assessed, and tokenized into the Vector ecosystem. This process mints Vector Share Tokens.


## FUNCTIONALITY /


The diagram to the right explains how an artwork becomes fractionalized in the Vector ecosystem.

A creator hash value identifies the unique artist that created the work, this is the source of their commissions from tradable shares.

Vector Shares are separated into two blocks – the ownership block and the tradable block.

Information is permanently recorded and saved on our time-stamped ledger, which become data points for analysis and reports.





## **INSTITUTIONS / CURATORS**

Ability to turn works of art into a liquid asset that can be fractionalized. Virtual gallery space to host exhibitions and events. Museums & Galleries catalog their art collection in the Vector ledger system.

Entire stock can be visible to a global audience. Manage inventory and sales in one place. Analyze and record real time data.

Artwork bought and sold through the Vector platform.Artist's receive ongoing royalties from tokenized artwork.Cataloging system for works of art that stores valuable information with greatly refined data collection and organization.

## **ARTISTS, CREATORS /**

Artists are curated into Vector. Access to tools to manage their work. Residual tracking, sales data, and listings.

Vector Productions Inc. is a c-corp based in New York City - we will be incorporating a new non-profit subsidiary called the "Vector Foundation". Vector has been in existence for over 15 years - We publish the International Artist Zine Vector. We host international events such as Vector Sound, Vector Video, and a Vector Performance series. We have a podcast called Vector Interview, which focuses on long-form interviews with artists. In the future, all of the creative projects will be handled through the Vector Foundation.

We believe passionately that the power of the Artists Vision is a driving force in the evolution of attitudes, ideas, and culture - which must be enhanced to challenge and inspire the world. The Vector Foundation's mission is to provide creative and financial support through grants, publications, events, exhibitions, lectures, residencies, non-profit creative blockchain projects, and yet unknown future possibilities.

#### GRANTS

As the Vector ecosystem grows we will be able to provide grants to: Artists, Fine Art Graduate Programs, Nonprofits, Artists in Residencies, Museums, Artists Run Galleries, and Projects Spaces.

#### ARTIST IN RESIDENCY

We will have an ongoing Artist in Residence at our headquarters in New York City. We can expand this to our international locations as Vector grows.

#### **ART PROJECTS**

We will continue curating and producing our international art events projects: Vector Artist Journal, Vector Video, Sound, Performance, Vector Interview Podcast, and Iaunch Vector Project Spaces in key cities around the world where we can have curated exhibitions of the art fund collection.

#### **ART & BLOCKCHAIN**

The Vector Blockchain will enable smart contracts. With a primary focus on fine and experimental art - we will have a program to help curate and jumpstart creative projects by artists and art institutions using blockchain technology.

Once the beta of the Vector Fine Art Meta-Chain Ecosystem is in place, we will start development of [Vectorspace] our version of virtual land, which will be structured precisely for the needs of the Artworld. We will provide all the space, technology, and the basic user interface to build and enhance the environments - but the real gem will be the things people design and code themselves. Currently this is an idea, over the next 18 months as we development the entire platform, we will work out and publish the details of the concept. Here is an quick overview of the possibilities:
